13. The Remnant and its Mission

"The prophecies of the book of Revelation clearly outline the mission of the remnant. The Three Angels' messages of Revelation 14:6-12 reveal the proclamation of the remnant that will bring a full and final restoration of the gospel truth.

These three messages comprise God's answers to the overwhelming satanic deception that sweeps the world just before Christ's return {Revelation 13:3, 8. 14-16, Emphasis supplied}. Immediately following God's last appeal to the world Christ returns to reap the harvest {Revelation 14:14-20}. " ²
