Who Do You trust?

Scenario: You're a new babe in Christ and you want to learn Bible truth, to whom do you go to teach you Biblical truths; a carpenter, a plumber, an electrician, commercial fisherman, or perhaps one who is a trained theological Bible instructor? Satan can, and will transform himself into to any of the above to achieve his purpose-deception. ⁴

Satan is a Bible theological mastermind. He knows the scriptures better than any human on earth, and he can certainly pervert God's Word to confuse and ensnare well-meaning Bible students. ⁵

Beware of so-called "spiritual guides," that claim to guide you on your "spiritual journey" that puts you more in touch with God's Spirit, while seeking some sort higher, intellectual, spiritual awareness leading to a hypothetical "journey to a spiritual Mecca" – at the same time teaching you to chant religious mantras, lighting candles, and practicing controlled breathing, "emptying oneself," {yoga – a group of related Hindu disciplines that promote "Unity" of the individual with "a supreme being" through a system of "postures and rituals" }.

"Today the mysteries of heathen worship are replaced by the secret associations and séances, the obscurities and wonders, of spiritualistic mediums, {somebody who is supposedly able to convey messages between the spirits of the dead and living people}.
