The battle was fought in Balaclava, Crimea against Russian forces in 1854. In spite of overwhelming odds British cavalry, led by Lord Cardigan, carried out their orders to charge. They all perished in the battle.² To this day no one knows who gave that fatal command.

What does this mean for us?

The British cavalry, known as the 'Light Brigade' faced tremendous odds, yet they charged the Russian forces, knowing that they had no hope of victory.

The good shepherd-the Lamb of God, has never lost a member of His flock, while they were following His voice.

We know that the three Hebrews' lives were fortified with the Holy Scriptures.
