1. The Word of God

The Holy Scriptures are the *infallible revelation* of His will. They are the *standard of character*, the test of experience, *the authoritative revealer of doctrines*, and the *trustworthy record of God's acts in history*, {II Pet. 1:20, 21; II Tim. 3:16, 17; Ps. 119:105; Prov. 30:5, 6; Isa. 8:20; John 17:17; I Thess. 2:13; Heb. 4:12, {Emphasis supplied}. ²
