"Present Truth-Revisited"

What is "present truth"? This is a very important question asked by laity and clergy alike. In order to share "present truth" we must know what it is!

Words from God's inspired servant

"...Present truth" lies in the work of health reform as verily as in other feathers of gospel work. No one branch when separated from others can be a perfect whole ...When the **third's angel's message** is received in its fullness, health reform will be given its place in the councils of the conference, in the work of the church, in the home, at the table, and in all the household arrangements. Then the right arm will serve and protect the body.

But while the health work has its place in the promulgation of the third angel's message, its advocates must not in any way strive to make it take the place of the message. ¹

"Repent, repent, was the message rung out by John the Baptist in the wilderness. Christ's message to the people was "Except ye repent, you shall all likewise perish." ² Luke 13:5. And the apostles were commanded to preach everywhere that men should repent." ³

From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, Repent for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Matthew 4:17

Today we are to present the same "present truth" message that Jesus, and John the Baptist preached, using all the methods available to us.

Ellen White mentioned in 1915, {the very year she died-emphasis provided} that men are needed who

can use the press, {today social media-emphasis provided} to the best possible advantage, that the truth may be "given wings," to speed it to every nation, tongue, and people.⁴

Wings denote speed, and the urgency of getting the 'everlasting gospel,' in the contest of the "third Angel's message, {come out of Babylon my people} ⁵ to all the world, before Christ returns!

"The Lord desires his servants today to preach the old gospel doctrine, sorrow for sin, repentance, and confession. We want old-fashioned sermons, old-fashioned customs, {not to be confused with traditions of men, cold-lifeless messages-emphasis provided} old-fashioned mothers and fathers in Israel, {Spiritual Israel of course-emphasis}.
